ADMISSION PROCEDURES

To be admitted to NISC, students must be previously enrolled in an accredited school and in good standing academically and behaviorally. Applicants must also complete an application and submit records from previous schools. The admissions committee is responsible for the final admissions decision.

Candidates for admissions to NISC are required to complete the following admissions procedures:

Step 1 – Submit the following:

- Completed application
- School health form
- Health records
- Three current, color, passport size photos
- Copy of passport or birth certificate that provides proof of the child's month, day and year of birth. (Those not in English need to be officially translated.)
- Official school records and transcripts. (Those not in English need to be officially translated.)

Step 2 – Have an interview/testing appointment set for your child and pay the enrollment deposit of \$500.00

Step 3 – The admissions committee will review your child's records and test results and you will be informed of your child's acceptance or non-qualifying status to NISC.

Step 4 – Upon acceptance to NISC the registration fee of \$1500 for KA students or \$2500 for KB through grade 12 students must be paid to have your child fully enrolled as a student of NISC.
